Laying a Foundation

Read Genesis 6 through 9 to prepare for today's lesson. This story is found in The Beginner's Bible on pages 26-33. Please read it with your child.

Given today's current culture, we can especially identify with this week's story. Genesis 6:11 says, "Now the earth was corrupt in God's sight, and the earth was filled with violence. And God saw the earth, and behold, it was corrupt..." Can you imagine what the world must have been like at the time of Noah?

Yet we see that the Bible says of Noah, "Noah was a righteous man, blameless in his generation. Noah walked with God."

Today as you teach this lesson to your child, take a moment to commit again to the Lord to live like Noah, to walk with God. What a privilege to teach your child from such a young age of what it means to walk with God in the midst of a corrupt culture. Especially remember to point out the rainbow from Genesis 9:13. The rainbow was specifically given by God as a sign of the covenant that God made between Himself and all the people on the earth. It is a promise of His great faithfulness!

- Use the questions below to talk about what they have learned today while making the craft.

Use these questions to help you review the story with your child:

- Who was the man in today's story? (Noah)
- What did God tell Noah to do? (build an ark)
- What happened when the boat was finished? What did God bring to the boat? (two of every kind of animal, one boy and one girl animal)
- What did the dove bring to the boat when Noah sent it out of the window? (an olive branch)
- What did Noah's family do when they were finally able to leave the boat? (They stopped to praise God.)
- What was the sign that God put in the sky to remind all people that He always keeps His promises? (the rainbow)
