Laying a Foundation

Read Genesis 2 and 3 to prepare for today's lesson. This story is found in The Beginner's Bible on pages 14-25. Please read it with your child.

Today's Art is **Making a Snake**

- Please help your child cut the snake on the solid black line.
- Help the children glue the googly eyes on the snake.
- Use the questions below to talk about what they have learned today while making the craft.

Talk

Use these questions to help you review the story with your child:

- God made a beautiful garden for Adam. What was Adam's job in the garden? (to name all of the animals)
- Who did God make to be a friend for Adam? (a woman, Eve)
- What did God tell Adam and Eve about the fruit trees in the garden? (that they could eat from all of the trees except for one, the tree of the knowledge of good and evil)
- Who also lived in the garden and came and asked Eve "Did God really tell you not to eat from the fruit from this tree?" (the snake)
- Why did the snake ask Eve to eat the fruit? (he wanted her to disobey God)
- Did they eat the fruit? (yes, Eve ate the fruit and gave some to Adam who ate it too.)
- What happened because Adam and Eve disobeyed God? (The snake had to crawl on its belly and Adam and Eve had to leave the garden.)

Dear God, Today's story reminds us of how important it is for us to obey You. But no matter how much we try, sometimes we still mess up! This story reminds us of how we are not able to do the right thing on our own and how we need Your help. Thank you for sending Jesus to pay the price for the wrong things we have done.
